### **7. What Nature Says About The Law & Order**

- The signs of the times show that we are living in a world of turmoil and distress, and so the condition of society prompts an important question, "What is the Key to a Better World?"
- Mankind has made many laws to combat the potential breakdown of society.
- Q: What trend is at the source of societal decay? Prov. 14:12 or 16:25
- A: Man's way of doing things may seem right, but it isn't, and leads to death.
- Over 20+ civilizations have come and gone, yet we can learn from nature, because it is rare to find self-destruction in the animal world; as a result of the direct effects of its own actions.
- Q: What's the difference in this regard, between the human and animal worlds? Luke 8:25?
- A: The difference is that nature respects and follows the laws that govern it.
- Plant and animals use them to live a better life.
  
- There are general Laws that govern all earthly creation such as the law of gravity, law of friction, the laws which govern elements.
- Animal species survive and thrive when they must meticulously follow the laws by which they are governed to the extent that you can set your watch by them.
- Q: Are we intended to live such orderly lives? 1 Cor.14:33,40
- A: Yes, everything is to be done decently and in order.
  
- God has provided us with the 10 Commandments, if we only followed, the 20+ civilizations would not have fallen.
- Q: What is the difference between man's law and God's law? Psalm 19:7,11
- A: "The law of the Lord is perfect, ...And in keeping them there is great reward."
- Orderly governments know that society cannot be harmonious, happy and safe without laws. Can you imagine our society without rules?
- Q: How does Jesus link love and the law? John 14:15
- A: If you love Me keep My commandments.
- We are motivated to love our loved ones because of love.
- Q: Is it permissible to break just one of the 10 Commandments? James 2:10
- No, they are all as important as each other, if you break one you break them all.
- The 10 Commandments provide and protect the whole person, physically, mentally, and spiritually.
- Q: What is the key to a better world? Ecclesiastes 12:13 or Rev 14:6,7
- A: Keep the law of God.
